- I. Isaiah 36-37 is narrative. Those who teach narrative should focus on these items:
  - a. Read or retell the story
  - b. Note specific theological language used in the story.
  - c. Note the repetitions.
- II. Isaiah 36-37 divides into 9 parts.

36:1-10	Taunt by Rabshakeh
36:11-12	Response I by Eliakim
36:13-22	Taunt II by Rabshakeh
37:1-7	Response II by Hezekiah & Isaiah
37:8-13	Taunt III by Rabshakeh
37:14-20	Response III by Hezekiah's prayer
37:21-29	Response IV by Isaiah's oracle
37:30-35	Sign and praise by Isaiah
37:36-38	Conclusion
