Whole Offering	1. <u>Fulfill a vow</u> 2. <u>Freewill offering</u> 3. <u>Appeal to the Lord</u> 4. <u>Atonement</u>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Entire animal burned</u></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Complete Surrender</u> to God</p>
Grain Offering	<p style="text-align: center;"><i>No independent purpose</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><i>Brought in conjunction with other sacrifices</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><i>Contributed to the completion of the primary sacrifice.</i></p>
Peace Offering	1. <u>Thanksgiving</u> 2. <u>Fulfill a vow</u> 3. <u>Freewill offering</u>	1. <u>Some of animal burned</u> 2. The rest <u>eaten as a special meal</u>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Joy and Celebration</u></p>
Sin Offering <hr/> Guilt Offering	<p style="text-align: center;">Atonement</p> 1. <u>Restraints or calms anger</u> 2. <u>Cleanses or removes an offense</u> 3. <u>Forgiveness of the sinner</u> 4. <u>Consecrate to an especially holy status</u>	<p>Before the Sacrifice the <u>person</u> must:</p> 1. <u>realize their offense</u> 2. <u>recognize their guilt</u> 3. <u>confess their sin</u> 4. <u>make restitution</u> (when appropriate) <p style="text-align: center;">The Sacrifice ...</p> 1. The <i>person</i> <u>kill the animal</u> 2. The <i>priest</i> <u>manipulates the blood</u>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>The Heart and Forgiveness</u></p> Israel's atonement was by <u>God's Grace</u> and only by <u>God's Grace!</u> <p>But... Salvation by <u>Grace</u> does not <u>set aside human responsibility</u></p>
