Solomon The last king of united Israel

Solomon's Triumphs:

- 1. He builds the <u>Temple</u>.
- 2. He rules with great Wisdom.
- 3. He conducts massive building projects.
- 4. He brings incredible <u>Wealth</u> into the nation.

Solomon's Problems:

- 1. His building projects were wonderful, but They exacted a heavy toll in <u>taxes and forced labor</u> Solomon may have exceed his ability to <u>pay for his projects</u>.
- 2. He amassed a large army of horses and chariots. (I Kgs 10:26-29; Deut 17:16)
- 3. He married many foreign women. (I Kgs 10:1-8; Deut 17:17)

Solomon's Tragic Legacy: I Kgs 11:9-13

Because of his failures, the kingdom will be torn away from him and divided.

The Kingdom Divides 922 BCE

North: <u>Israel</u> King: <u>Jeroboam</u> South: <u>Judah</u> King: <u>Rehoboam</u>
