Theme: The God high and holy sends a preacher

63:1-6 - God's solo effort to establish justice.

These verses appear to be a conversation between the watchman and God.

63:7-14 - God's long history of loyalty to Israel

The prophet speaks of 3 issues.

1. God's past work with Israel.
2. An appeal for God to come again and help Israel
3. A confession of Israel's sin.

63:15-64:4 - The prophet's plea to God is to come again and help Israel.

64:5-12 - The prophet confesses the sins of Israel.
