3. Why believe in any gods at all?
 - a. There is a very basic reason why the belief in gods is so common all over the world and throughout history: On the face of things, it is practically impossible to imagine the personal arising from the less than personal.

4. Why believe there is one God instead of many?
 - a. The Simplicity Principle: When any two explanations are equal in other ways, the simpler one is more likely to be true.

 - b. The Simplicity Principle probably explains why people are drawn toward the idea of one God over many. But more than that, it shows that they are right to think in this way. If everything else is the same, one God is more likely than many gods.
